Religions for Peace

Report of the year 2016/2017:

The roles of Religions for Peace Malaysia in 2016/2017 is played through promulgation of peace education, peace dialogue and the globalization of peace culture to build and maintain unity and harmony in Malaysia as well as in other parts of Asia and the world. The major objectives of Religions for Peace Malaysia in 2016/2017 has been to advance multi-religious action for the common good; to transform conflict, promote just and harmonious societies, advance human development, and protect the earth; and to publish multi-religious teaching and learning materials, such as DVD, books and various research publications. The major activities are listed as below:

1. Interfaith Forum on Common Misconceptions of Religious Practices and Differences in the Concept of God in Malaysia

Date: 4th February 2017

The contents and context of the Interfaith Forum were from the perspectives of Buddhism, Christianity, Hinduism and Islam, mainly to explore the common misconceptions of religious practices and differences in the concept of God. For example, in Buddhism, the common misconceptions of religious practices are the literal worships of the Buddha and Bodhisattvas' statues; in fact, it is the arts of teaching and learning in Buddhism Education, for example Buddha Statue symbolised the Original Nature or Nature Virtuous; and Bodhisattvas' statues symbolised the Cultivation Virtuous. From the perspective of Buddhism, there are several different concepts of God stated in Chinese Mahayana Buddhism. The first concept of God is One True God, which is known as Buddha Nature, Dharma Nature, Original Nature, Nature Virtuous, True Mind, Self-Nature, Buddha Matrix, True Nature, True Mind and other related terms; the second concept of God is Alaya or Soul, which is regarded as the creator of the universe; and the third concept of God is the owner of the Heavens.





2. Forum on Drugs: Prevention and Treatment from Religious Perspectives on Anti-Drug Programs, Jihad against Drugs

The contents and context of the Forum on Drugs: Prevention and Treatment from Religious Perspectives on Anti-Drug Programs applied inner spiritual power or Jihad against drugs. For example, in Buddhism, the application of inner spiritual power against drugs emphasized on meditation mainly, (1) the Five Precepts of disciplines; (2) development of the Mind of Enlightenment; (3) using natural treatment methods through repentance; remembrance, worshiping and praying to the Three Saints from Western Pure Land (Bodhisattva Mahasthamaprata, Buddha Amitabha, and Bodhisattva Avalokitesvara); and (4) emulate the Spiritual Combat Power of Bodhisattva Veda Dharmapala and Bodhisattva Guan Gong, etc. This forum was organized by PEMADAM as an awareness effort towards the issue of drug abuse and rehabilitation. PEMADAM is a Non-Governmental Organization that defends the fate and welfare of former drug addicts throughout Malaysia.





3. First Batch Taoism on Taishang Ganying Pian or Treatise of the Exalted One on Response and Retribution lessons for Public in Malaysia
