

Annual Work Report in 2021 (CCRP)

From January to October 2021, Mr. Deng Zongliang, Executive Vice President, Ven. Yanjue and Mr. Li Guangfu, Vice Presidents of CCRP, attended four video conferences of Religions for Peace (RfP) International Council and reviewed the work performance.

On January 27, 2021, representatives of CCRP attended IPCR Seminar, which was hosted by Korean Conference of Religions and Peace (KCRP) in the form of video conference.

On April 21, 2021, Buddhist and Islamic members of CCRP attended Religious Sub-forum of Boao Forum for Asia 2021. They exchanged views on the wisdom and responsibility of religion in the construction of the “Belt and Road” Initiative, and expounded on that the people of all ethnic groups fully enjoy the right to freedom of religious belief and normal religious activities are held in an orderly manner in Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, China, as well as religious leaders’ participation in the deliberation and administration of state affairs in China.

In May 2021, CCRP invited representatives of the five major religions to embark on study tours and conduct exchanges in the Southern provinces of China, visited local temples, churches, and mosques, held talks with local religious leaders, discussed and shared views upon the ways for the Chinese religious community to conduct foreign exchanges in a more efficient manner, which harvested satisfactory fruits.

In August 2021, CCRP issued *Proposal on Prayer for Peace in Commemoration of the 76th Anniversary of the Victory of the Chinese People’s War of Resistance against Japanese Aggression and the World Anti-Fascist War* to the five major religious groups of five major religions based in China. They responded actively to the appeal and launched relevant prayer campaigns around September 3, 2021.

Throughout the year 2021, entrusted by CCRP President Ven. Pagbalha Geleg Namgyai, Mr. Deng Zongliang successively presided over secretary-general meetings, president meetings, board member meetings and plenary meetings to evaluate work performance of CCRP. CCRP members vigorously shared their opinions and suggestions, and exchanged views on many issues.

Mr. Lacan, Secretary-General of CCRP, attended Video Conference of ACRP 5G meetings, and reported on the work progress in CCRP. Representatives of CCRP attended meetings of the 9th Assembly of ACRP, put forward opinions and suggestions on related work, and played an active role in the preparations for the Assembly.
