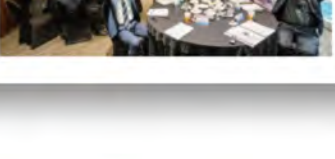
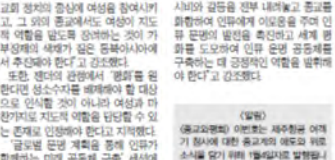
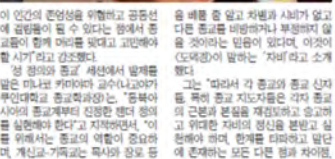

Participants:

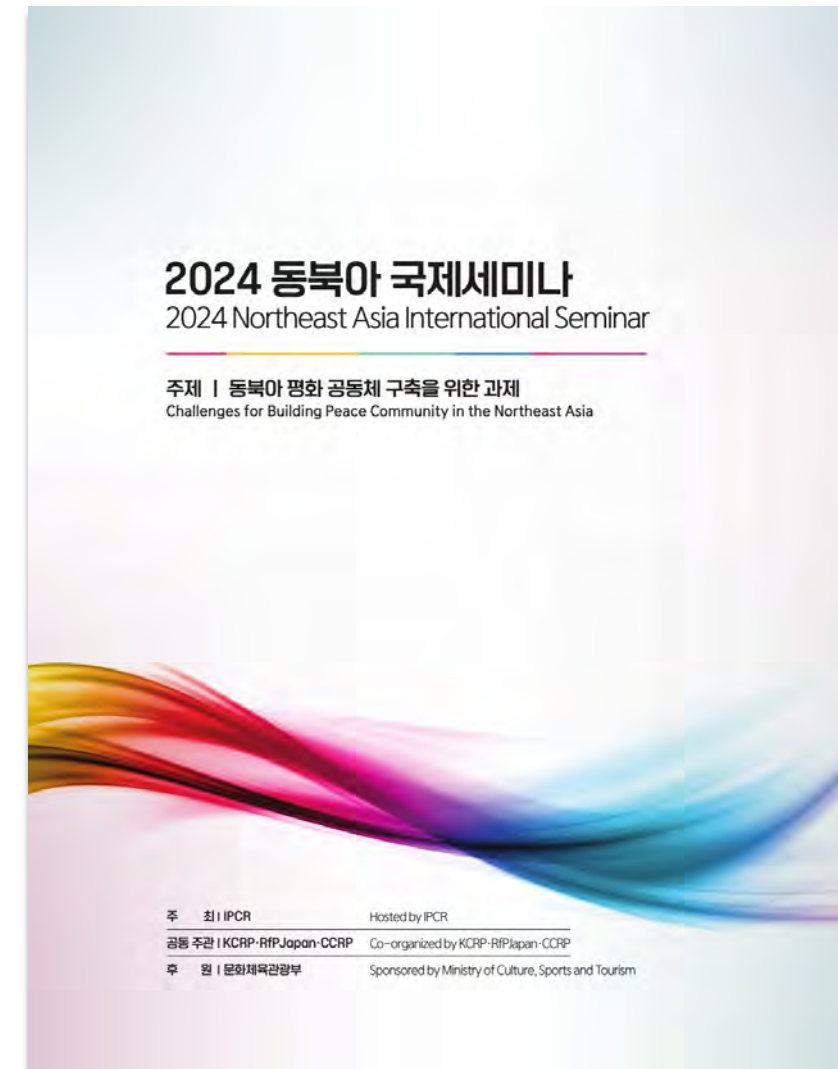
Approximately 50 religious leaders and scholars from Korea, China, and Japan, along with representatives from relevant organizations.

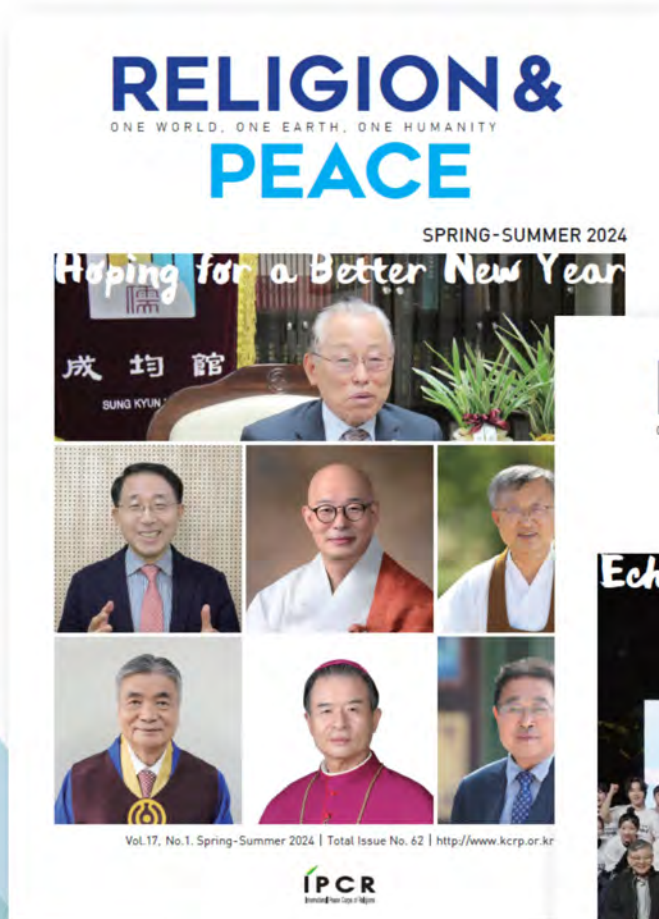
