# **Coming events:**

## 1. Visit to Fiji to connect Fiji to ACRP

The ACRP Moderator, Associate Secretary General Oceania etc. have a firmer plan to visit Fiji to meet with Multifaith groups and faith representatives, tentatively planned for August 2025.

Throughout 2024-25, RfP Australia has had several sub-committee meetings to develop plans and gather information.

We thank Kanti Jinna, Dean Sahu Khan from Canberra Interfaith Forum and our Chair Philippa Rowland for linking with the Fiji High Commissioner (this took several attempts and meetings) to discuss RfP Asia's wish to link with Multifaith people in Fiji. The Fijian High Commissioner was supportive and gave us phone numbers of Multifaith people to contact in Fiji.

Dr Sarah Haggar and I had a Zoom meeting with Dr Thomas White (referred to us through Prof Paul Morris), an academic from The University of Otago who specialises in religion in Fiji. Dr White provided us with some great background to the status of religion, culture, and politics in Fiji, and he also gave us some insights into interfaith relations and organisations in Fiji. He suggested we reach out to Interfaith Search and continue trying to reach out to the Pacific Council of Churches.

Following the conversation with Dr White, and with the insight and phone numbers provided by the Fijian High Commissioner, a call was made to Jyoti Tappoo (Hindu) who is involved with Interfaith Search. This group has representatives from many faiths on it and meets on the second Wednesday evening of the month in Suva. Jyoti has reached out to the chair Mr Zoran Ali (Muslim) and asked him to contact us to discuss a suitable time for us to visit.

When we go, we may also meet with other faith communities i.e. Methodist and Pacific Council of Churches, although they may also be represented at the Interfaith Search meeting.

What was interesting is that Jyoti had attended the Parliament of World Religions 2008 in Melbourne, so she knew of RfP International's work and was interested that our Moderator Des Cahill was one of the pivotal people who organised that meeting.

2. The ACRP 2025 commemoration of the 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the dropping of the Atomic Bomb on Hiroshima and Nagasaki –
