### **Tree Planting for Peace**

As part of its lead-up activities for the upcoming **Chattogram Peace Summit 2025**, RfP Bangladesh organized a community-based initiative titled "Tree Planting for Peace" on Monday, 28 July 2025, in East Amuchia, Kanungopara, located in Boalkhali Upazila of Chattogram.

The event aimed to promote interfaith harmony, environmental awareness, and the spirit of peaceful coexistence. It brought together representatives of multiple faith communities in a symbolic effort to plant trees as a shared commitment to peace.
